Planning

The council was notified of planning application PA19/07034 (replace existing retaining wall at "Foxland") and has commented that the application is supported.

A correction

Further to the entry in the previous issue, we are pleased to clarify that the stone bench by the Pavilion to commemorate the centenary of this historic event was **part-**funded by the parish council – the balance was raised by the community.

Drones

There was some concern expressed at the recent Parish Council meeting about drones being flown over the village, both on grounds of safety and privacy. Drones must only be flown "in line of sight" (ie the operator has to be able to actually see the drone while it is being flown) and must not be flown closer than 50 metres to people, vehicles or buildings – or 150m in a "congested area". And if they are used for filming, you will need the consent of any person being filmed. See for example www.nottinghamshirepolice.uk/advice/drone-law-uk.
