New Bus Service

Saltash Red Bus (part of the charity Saltash Age Concern) run the school bus service, and are now proposing to use the vehicle (which would otherwise return empty) to offer a service to Saltash and back every Wednesday morning during both school terms and the holidays (but not on bank holidays).

It will start from St Ive Cross at 0850, then leave **Quethiock School at 0858**, and **Blunts at 0906**, travelling via Tideford Cross at 0916, Tideford at 0916, then Landrake, Trematon, and Forder, and Burraton (by the fish and chip shop) arriving at 0943, then stopping at Lidl, Home Bargains, Waitrose and B&M, then at the Leisure Centre at 0959 and the bottom of Fore Street at 1003.

The return journey starts at the bottom of Fore Street at 1330, the Leisure Centre at 1333, Waitrose 1339, B&M 1341, Home Bargains 1344, Lidl 1346, Burraton 1349, arriving Tideford 1413, Tideford Cross 1417, **Blunts 1423**, **Quethiock 1431** and St Ive Cross 1439.

We understand that the adult fare is about £3-3.50 each way, and the usual bus concessions will apply. They use a 16-seat vehicle – for wheelchair access please contact them beforehand to pre-book as they will need to remove some seats. If you live on the route but not near the stops listed, you can flag the bus down as it passes - if you want to wait at the Quethiock bus shelter then also flag it down as it comes from the school. The service will **start running on Wednesday 5th April 2023**. Just turn up!

This is a very welcome initiative, and a very "green" one, making use of what would otherwise be wasted miles, but it will only survive if it is used. We understand that if this service is supported by passengers there is a possibility of a similar service being run to and from Liskeard. 
