### Fly tipping

Every so often there are instances of fly-tipping around our lanes. If you spot this a report to Cornwall Council will alert them to it, and they will clear it away.

### Voting – photo ID

New rules mean that in future you will need to produce photo identification in order to vote. Acceptable documentation includes a passport or photo driving licence, PASS ID cards, disabled parking blue badges, and some concessionary travel passes such as older persons’ bus passes. further details are available on the Electoral Commission’s website, [electoralcommission.org.uk](http://electoralcommission.org.uk).

If you do not have any of these, you will need a ( free ) Voter Authority Certificate.
