Reporting Road Problems to Cornwall Council

Cornwall Council is responsible for maintaining highways and other public rights of way. By and large they are very good at responding when there is a problem. However, they are very reliant on members of the public alerting them to problems in the first place.

This is where you come in: if you find a problem – a fallen tree blocking the road, a pothole, a flood, or whatever it may be, please do report it to them. You can do this online at:

(or just search “Cornwall Council Highways” and you should find their “report a problem” page)

Their website is pretty easy to use, and it should not take more than a few minutes at most. You will get a reference number, and you can use that to check on progress subsequently.

If you do make a report, it would also be very helpful if you could drop an email to the Parish Council (clerk@quethiockparishcouncil.gov.uk), with the reference number, so that we are aware it has been reported and can monitor the outcome.
