## QUETHIOCK PARISH COUNCIL

### 20mph speed limits

You will have heard on the local news that Cornwall Council is introducing 20mph speed limits in certain areas. Quethiock Parish Council wrote to Cornwall Council in June last year asking for 20 mph limits in three areas, namely through Blunts, through Trehunist, and through Quethiock, including its outskirts.

Unfortunately, we have not yet had any response from anyone at Cornwall Council to these representations. Furthermore, according to Cornwall Council's website 20mph limits will not be applied anywhere where the existing limit is 40 mph or more. That would rule out all those locations apart from the centre of Quethiock - see the webpage at <https://www.cornwall.gov.uk/transport-parking-and-streets/roads-highways-and-pavements/20mph-speed-limits/>.

We are continuing to explore what if anything can be done about this. If you too are concerned, you may wish to take it up with our local Cornwall Councillor, Sharon Daw – her email is [cllr.sharon.daw@cornwall.gov.uk](mailto:cllr.sharon.daw@cornwall.gov.uk).
