Measles – important information

Cases of measles are rising across England. There are large outbreaks in London and Birmingham, and some outbreaks in the south-west already. NHS advises that it is only a matter of time before we see measles outbreaks in Cornwall.

Measles is an infection that spreads very easily and for some children and adults can cause serious problems. It is particularly easy to catch when in close contact with others, such as in nurseries and schools.

Symptoms include a high fever, sore red watery eyes and a blotchy red-brown rash. A child with measles should stay off nursery or school for at least 4 days from when the rash first appears, and avoid close contact with babies, and anyone who is pregnant or has a weakened immune system.

Measles often starts as cold-like symptoms. NHS guidance says it is fine to send a child to school with a minor cough or common cold, provided they don't have a temperature.

The best protection against measles for children and adults is to get both doses of the MMR vaccine. It is never too late to catch up on any missed MMR vaccinations

MMR is a preschool vaccination, normally given at 12 months and 3 years 4 months, to protect against Measles, Mumps and Rubella. <u>Both doses are needed for full protection</u>. Parents and guardians should check their children's MMR status, or contact their GP practice as soon as possible if they are not sure.


